Talk it up

Talk It Up! is a show about linguistics, the science of language. Linguist Daniel Midgley discusses the ins and outs of language with his friends Ben Ainslie and Kylie Sturgess.

Everything about language is on the table, including the peculiarities of English, how language changes, and how language interacts with society and culture.

Ben Ainslie teaches media studies to this generation of secondary school students. Kylie Sturgess studies skepticism and philosophy and is the voice of the Token Skeptic podcast.

Up over to down under

The series 'Up Over to Down Under' is a selection of intimate letters taken from Noelle White's book of the same name. It is a tribute to her late husband of nearly 50 years Peter, and a revealing snapshot of what it was like to live a world away from each other while making their wedding arrangements and plans for a life together on the family sheep property at Murrurundi NSW.

Once Were Aliens: Stories of Migration

A collection of stories from Australian migrants who have come from a variety of different places at different times. Czechoslovakia in the 50s from Afghanistan in the 2010s; the series gives a platform for migrants to tell their stories and aims to gain better understandings of their experiences and desires.

Uncovered

An informative series that delves beneath the surface of the hit songs we've come to love from certain artists – but not necessarily the original composers.

Uncovered takes you back to the beginning of some classic tunes, to discover the story behind the hits we all know and love.

Big ideas

Human Behaviour

Human Behaviour is a ten-part series of social studies and social etiquette. Over the course of the series we observe the evolution of our set of behavioural rules back to the mid-16th century.

There is an ongoing theme that develops throughout the series that suggests everything we do in the world is some type of performance. We are influenced by everything in our environment including television and pop culture.... and we don't realise exactly how much we are being influenced all the time. We have a mask for every occasion, and it is absolutely expected.

Off the record

A ten-part review series in which presenter/producer Brian Wise reviews recent releases, pays tribute to musicians who have passed away and wraps up the year in music.

This series looks at the career of legendary New Orleans musician Allen Toussaint and also reviews some of the more notable local and international releases as well as unveiling the story of Lucinda Williams' band Buick 6 and reviewing a new 4 CD box set titled The 100 Greatest Australian Singles of the '60s. There is also a review of a book on Australian promoter Michael Gudinski, Suzannah Espie's latest album and a discussion with Canadian musician Ron Sexsmith about songwriting.
